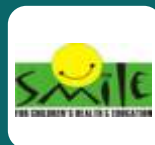

# A GLANCE of SURABI ACTIVITIES

The core program at Surabi is Brindavan-- a home for homeless children.

Abandoned children are vulnerable to exploitation by criminals and anti-social elements. As such Surabi seeks to identify such children and offer them a place of residence where they are provided food, shelter, education, sporting activities and programs geared to help nurture them to become responsible citizens of society.

Our Children Home is recognized by Government of TN



Brindavan not only offers children education but opportunities to learn and develop skills in sports, arts, music, and academic competitions. At present, Surabi has 12 deserving children in its care in the Brindavan program.

In the past six years since its inception the Brindavan program has helped 68 children, including a seventh grade school dropout completed diploma in electrical engineering and joined for work. A few other children are in highschool, about to graduate and go on to college.

## HEALTHY MOTHER

Surabi initiated the Healthy Mother program to support poor, pregnant women by offering them a 14-pulse powder to mix which provides the necessary protein, vitamins, carbohydrates needed to supplement the health of pregnant mothers. The powder is distributed free of cost on a weekly basis from the 2nd month pregnancy through child birth and the baby is 6 month old. We are distributing through primary health centers.



Monitoring & Evaluation are the two important factors of this program which helps us to maintain quality of the product as well as timely distribution to pregnant mothers. Inventory record is maintained for each mother on their periodical consumption and delivery of baby.

**Total Beneficiaries in 2017-18 = 483**

This product is manufactured in a hygienic environment. The powder is a mix of 14 pulse ingredients, which supplements all nutritional needs to a pregnant woman. This product is been approved by FSSAI and 100% natural without any preservatives. This powder is directly reaches the beneficiary.



# ACTIVITIES Cont...

## BALAMITRA

Food nutrition rolls made from powdered or ground pulses (beans, chick peas/channa, etc.) with jaggery (traditional non-centrifuged sugar) added to taste, are offered as breakfast to students. Surabi offers this nutritious food to about 700 children daily. Surabi has received positive feedback from schools that children like this food and that this program has enabled students improve their health as well as school performance.



This BALAMITRA Nutrition Breakfast Supplement program helps children to overcome their morning hunger helps them to concentrate on their studies. The indirect impact is that it improves the general health of the child, helps to improve growth in their height & weight their BMI is maintained. This is also helping in decrease of absenteeism in schools.

We are aware that many Corporation School children up to the 5th standard level do not eat breakfast and are attending schools on an empty stomach. Children deprived of breakfast cannot concentrate on their studies. Considering the importance of this, Surabi initiated the Bala Mitra (Nutrition Supplement Program) to help these children.

**Total Beneficiaries in 2017-18 = 700 Daily.**

## VOCATIONAL

The literacy level among women in India is low and are suppressed in society. Surabi is striving to empower women and enable them to earn their livelihood. In association with LaurusEdutech (<https://www.laurusedutech.com/>), a franchisee of the National Skill Development Corporation (<http://nsdcindia.org/>), we are conducting classes in Tailoring, Cosmetology, and Computers. Many of the graduates of these programs are now self-employed, and some of them have found careers in outside industry and business.

# SHELTER HOME

Surabi is running a shelter home for the homeless of Chennai. Surabi Shelter Home can accommodate 40 inhabitants - from children to adults. This shelter is a project fully supported by the Corporation of Chennai and managed by Surabi.

Surabi Shelter Home seeks to provide a safe, secure and homely environment for the inhabitants.

The first sign of modern homelessness in Chennai was the appearance of hundreds of homeless old age men & women, families with children sleeping in parks, on sidewalks, in transportation terminals and in other public spaces. Historically the city had seen pockets of street homelessness in the sight of homeless adults, many of them men living with mental illness. All these men are bedding down on streets became more commonplace throughout the city. Homeless women, both those with children and without have experience higher rates of physical illness than men. Many old aged men and women are been thrown to streets by their own kith and kin, due to old age illness, poverty, domestic problems. And at the same time deaths and injuries among street homeless also became common routine.

**Total Beneficiaries in 2017-18 = 202**

# OMNI VAN

We are spending huge amounts on transport for our children to participate in various programs. We also feel it difficult to take our children to Hospitals in emergency. During rush hours in the morning our children are going to school by public transport which they feel it difficult and it is also becoming hazardous. Primary children of SURABI are studying in a different school for which we have engaged an Auto for that we are spending much amount. This vehicle will help us to curtail down the cost as well as children can go to school safely.

In our BALAMITRA program we are distributing nutrition breakfast at various Corporation schools in Chennai for which we have to visit and distribute the food in the morning at each school everyday. We are presently carrying this food on a two wheeler in two trips. In the morning peak hours it is becoming difficult to reach in time. This vehicle will help us to reach schools in time and in a single trip we can cover all the schools. We can carry the food in safe and secure manner. Even when we increase the number of beneficiary schools we can easily reach schools in time in a single trip.

In our HEALTHY MOTHER program we are distributing nutrition powder to poor pregnant women through 6 primary health centers for which we are carrying around 100 kgs to each primary center. Presently we are carrying in two wheeler which is inconvenient.



Donors are used to contribute some valuables, old newspapers and old clothes, presently we are carrying these on two wheeler with difficulty. Extra manpower is also required to carry on a two wheeler. To reach more Donors in time we require a vehicle.

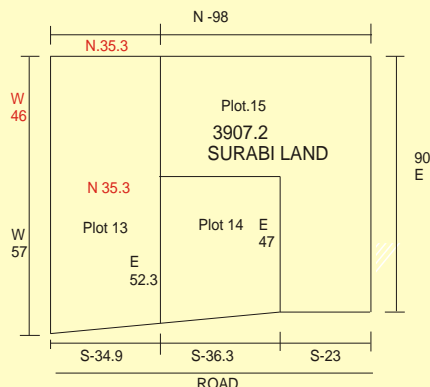
# Our New Initiatives...

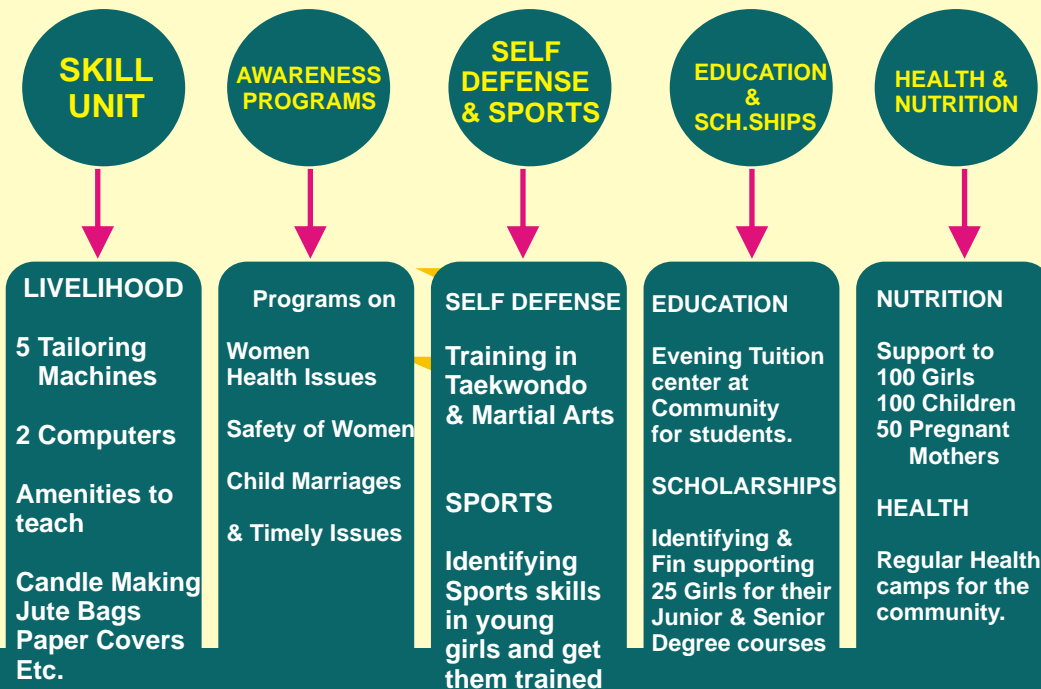
